

ACT Contemporary Theatre Announces Elisabeth Farwell-Moreland as Interim Producing Artistic Director



SEATTLE, WA (August 22, 2024) – Seattle's ACT
Contemporary Theatre announced today the hiring of
Elisabeth Farwell-Moreland as Interim Producing Artistic
Director, effective immediately. Farwell-Moreland will oversee the
Artistic and Executive teams while ACT continues merger
discussions with Seattle Shakespeare Company.

Farwell-Moreland brings to ACT an immense depth of knowledge, trust, and leadership experience from within the Pacific Northwest theatre community. She previously served as

Producing Director and Artistic Producer at Seattle Rep for 15 years, and most recently as Interim Director of Production at Village Theatre. She also teaches stage management programs at both the University of Washington and Cornish College of the Arts.

"Seattle's theatre community is so strong and resilient, but we know this is a time of great challenge as we continue to rebuild after the pandemic," said Farwell-Moreland. "I was so excited to hear about the collaboration between ACT and Seattle Shakespeare, as I believe that true innovative collaboration between our arts organizations is how we build our future and continue to tell our stories. I am thrilled and honored to support ACT in this time of transition, with a focus on ensuring the voices of our community and local artists remain front and center."

"I could not think of a more perfect person than Elisabeth to guide ACT through this exciting time," said departing **ACT Artistic Director John Langs**. "She knows the lay of the land of our community, having worked extensively at two of the largest theaters in Seattle. Elisabeth has a reputation as a levelheaded problem solver that centers the well-being of the artists and administrators around her."



A national search for a permanent Artistic Director will begin following the completion of the merger between ACT Contemporary Theatre and Seattle Shakespeare Company, tentatively slated for early 2025.

ACT begins their 2024/25 Season on September 7 with *POTUS: Or, Behind Every Great Dumbass Are Seven Women Trying to Keep Him Alive* by Selina Fillinger. Tickets are available now at acttheatre.org.
